If you are a Native American student, enrolled or descendant, with a 3.0 GPA or above, you are invited to apply to our *Indigenous Scholars of Promise* program. These college preparation programs will provide students with training, mentoring, and support services to help them prepare to apply to the colleges and universities of their choice.

Benefits of being a Scholar of Promise:

- Training and coaching meetings to help prepare you to apply to colleges/universities and succeed once you are there.
- Assistance with university essays, application/testing fees, and scholarship applications.
- Mentor and peer support throughout the college preparation process.
- Recognition through participation in the Scholars of Promise program.
